| <b>Main control</b><br>Classify the relationship, map every statutory condition and preserve authority, execution and performance evidence. | <b>Top risk</b><br>Using a template or label without testing event-date law, consent, title, authority, limitation and State overlays. |
| <b>Remedy</b><br>Quantify breach and loss, mitigate, issue a valid notice and select the correct substantive relief and forum.              | <b>State alert</b><br>Partnership Rules, forms, fees, Registrar portals, stamp duty and public-notice practice are State/UT-specific.  |

## Five-point professional checklist

1. Freeze event date, parties and transaction.
2. Map statutory limbs and exceptions.
3. Verify authority, consent, stamp, registration and evidence.
4. Calculate price, loss, partner accounts or relief and limitation.
5. Select notice, remedy, forum and settlement path.
