

Chapter IV - Appeals - One-page Cheat Sheet

Filing gate: classify commercial dispute, specified value, current notified forum and section 12A PIMS/urgent-relief status before institution.

Chapter in 2 Minutes

- Appeals lie only to the specified Commercial Appellate forum, generally within sixty days, and interlocutory appealability is tightly limited.
- The appellate court or division should endeavour to dispose of the appeal within six months.
- Apply the current State/High Court notification and commercial CPC Schedule, not the Act heading alone.

Gate	Status	Meaning	Action
Section 13	Current / mapped	Appeals lie only to the specified Commercial Appellate forum, generally within sixty days, and interlocutory appealability is tightly limited.	Prepare an appealability and limitation note before challenging any order; separate decree appeal, enumerated interlocutory appeal, arbitration appeal and constitutional remedy.
Section 14	Current / mapped	The appellate court or division should endeavour to dispose of the appeal within six months.	Prepare an appealability and limitation note before challenging any order; separate decree appeal, enumerated interlocutory appeal, arbitration appeal and constitutional remedy.
