

Commercial Dispute Classification Master - One-page Cheat Sheet

Filing gate: classify commercial dispute, specified value, current notified forum and section 12A PIMS/urgent-relief status before institution.

Chapter in 2 Minutes

- Apply every section 2(1)(c) category, the immovable-property trade-use test, State/public body explanation and exclusions.
- Convert the transaction category into a dated evidence-backed control.
- Convert the immovable trade use into a dated evidence-backed control.
- Convert the state/public party into a dated evidence-backed control.

Provision / control map

Gate	Status	Meaning	Action
Gate 1	Matter-specific	Test transaction category using current Act, Rules, notifications, CPC Schedule and local practice.	Assign an owner, deadline, approval and exception route for transaction category.
Gate 2	Matter-specific	Test immovable trade use using current Act, Rules, notifications, CPC Schedule and local practice.	Assign an owner, deadline, approval and exception route for immovable trade use.
Gate 3	Matter-specific	Test state/public party using current Act, Rules, notifications, CPC Schedule and local practice.	Assign an owner, deadline, approval and exception route for state/public party.
Gate 4	Matter-specific	Test commercial nexus using current Act, Rules, notifications, CPC Schedule and local practice.	Assign an owner, deadline, approval and exception route for commercial nexus.

Current Act/Rules/notification; contract and authority; classification/value/limitation; PIMS; pleadings and Statement of Truth; disclosure/e-records; case calendar; costs/interest; appeal and enforcement.
