

FININ2MIN | LIMITATION ACT, 1963

Part III - Computation of period of limitation

Build a date-by-date chronology and test each exclusion, postponement, fresh-start and continuing-wrong rule independently.

Chapter in 2 Minutes

- Section 12 governs exclusion of time in legal proceedings; isolate its actor, trigger, conditions, exceptions and legal consequence before computing time.
- Section 13 governs indigent-person application exclusion; isolate its actor, trigger, conditions, exceptions and legal consequence before computing time.
- Wrong-forum time is excluded only after proving diligence, good faith, same matter/relief and a jurisdiction-like defect.
- Section 15 governs other statutory exclusions; isolate its actor, trigger, conditions, exceptions and legal consequence before computing time.
- Section 16 governs effect of death before accrual; isolate its actor, trigger, conditions, exceptions and legal consequence before computing time.

Section 16	Section 16 governs effect of death before accrual; isolate its actor, trigger, conditions, exceptions and legal consequence before computing time.	Source text, chronology, contract/order, communications, proof of service, computation sheet, approvals and filing acknowledgment.
Section 17	Fraud or mistake postpones time to discovery subject to diligence and protected third-party interests.	Source text, chronology, contract/order, communications, proof of service, computation sheet, approvals and filing acknowledgment.

Evidence file

Instrument/order; trigger and service proof; computation; copy/stay/notice records; acknowledgment/payment evidence; special-law text; authority; filing receipt.

Do not use a generic three-year assumption. The special statute, exact Schedule article, third-column trigger and event-date amendments control. Official source prevails.
