

Ninth Schedule - Commercial Courts Act amendment - One-page Cheat Sheet

Commencement gate: do not use any statutory consequence without checking S.O. 4384(E) and later Gazette notifications.

Chapter in 2 Minutes

- Substitutes the Chapter IIIA / section 12A pre-institution mediation framework.
- Section 64 is not commenced under the reviewed commencement notification; existing Commercial Courts Act and PIMS Rules require separate current-law analysis.
- Use the India Code Act and the Department of Legal Affairs Gazette files as controlling sources.
- Separate the Mediation Act from existing Commercial Courts, consumer, company, court-annexed and special-statute mediation rules.

Transaction control	Do not assume effective	Substitutes the Chapter IIIA / section 12A pre-institution mediation framework.	Update contracts/forms only after legal effective-date memo.
Litigation control	Event-date law applies	Pending and transitional matters require separate analysis.	Case chronology, pleadings and applicable law snapshot.
