

Mediation Council of India (Forms and Manner of Annual Statement of Accounts) Rules, 2024 - One-page Cheat Sheet

Commencement gate: do not use any statutory consequence without checking S.O. 4384(E) and later Gazette notifications.

Chapter in 2 Minutes

- Forms, accounting statements, approvals, CAG-linked audit and submission controls under sections 46 and 51.
- This is one of three final 2024 Council governance/accounts rules identified in the reviewed official ecosystem; it does not by itself operationalise uncommenced substantive provisions.
- Use the India Code Act and the Department of Legal Affairs Gazette files as controlling sources.
- Separate the Mediation Act from existing Commercial Courts, consumer, company, court-annexed and special-statute mediation rules.

Gate	Status	Meaning	Action
Rule identity	Commenced on Gazette publication	Forms, accounting statements, approvals, CAG-linked audit and submission controls under sections 46 and 51.	Map every rule to section 51 and the connected substantive section.
Governance owner	Current	Administrative rule; it does not commence uncommenced mediation-process provisions.	Assign HR, finance, secretariat, audit and legal owners.
Change control	Ongoing	Use current Gazette version rather than a web summary.	Quarterly source check and redline register.

Contract, commencement/special-law memo, invitation/service, mediator disclosure, authority, protected and independent evidence indexes, settlement, stamp/tax, payment and enforcement records.
