

Chapter XI - Acceptance and Payment for Honour and Reference in Case of Need

Chapter in 2 minutes

- Verify protest prerequisites, written acceptance/payment for honour, identity, recourse and rights acquired.
- Primary control: honour intervention gate.
- Verify protest, written acceptance/payment and recourse rights before intervention.
- Apply the exact current section text, amendment history and transaction evidence together.
- Do not confuse a negotiable instrument remedy with automatic proof of the underlying transaction.

Execution gates

- Legally enforceable transaction
- Instrument classification and stamp
- Authority/mandate and custody
- Presentation, return and notice clocks
- Evidence, forum and entity liability
- Settlement, accounting and retention

Provision/control map

Provision	Subject	Control
Section 108	Acceptance for honour.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.
Section 109	How acceptance for honour must be made.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.
Section 110	Acceptance not specifying for whose honour it is made.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.
Section 111	Liability of acceptor for honour.	Map every party, capacity, signature, notice, consent, payment and loss before concluding exposure.
Section 112	When acceptor for honour may be charged.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.
Section 113	Payment for honour.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.
Section 114	Right of payer for honour.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.
Section 115	Drawee in case of need.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.
Section 116	Acceptance and payment without protest.	Identify trigger, parties, conditions, exceptions, consequence and linked sections before execution.

Evidence file

Instrument/image; mandate; contract/invoice/delivery; ledger/bank/tax; presentment/return; notice/service; calculations; settlement/orders; source log.

Default response

Freeze timeline; verify debt and authority; preserve originals; validate bank memo; calculate statutory/civil clocks; decide cure, notice, settlement and filing.
